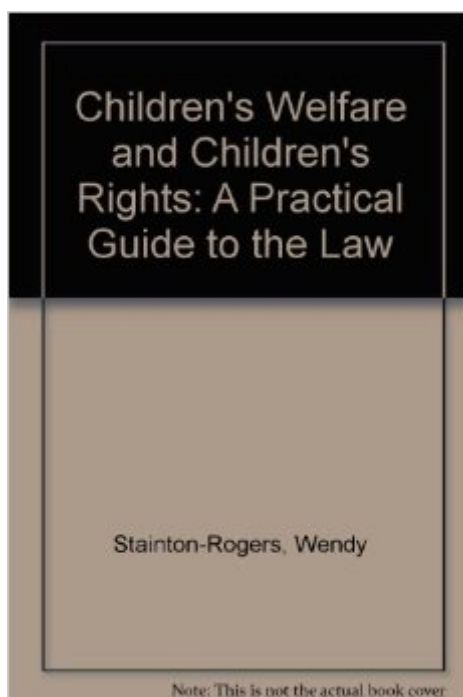


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Children's Welfare And Children's Rights: A Practical Guide To The Law
