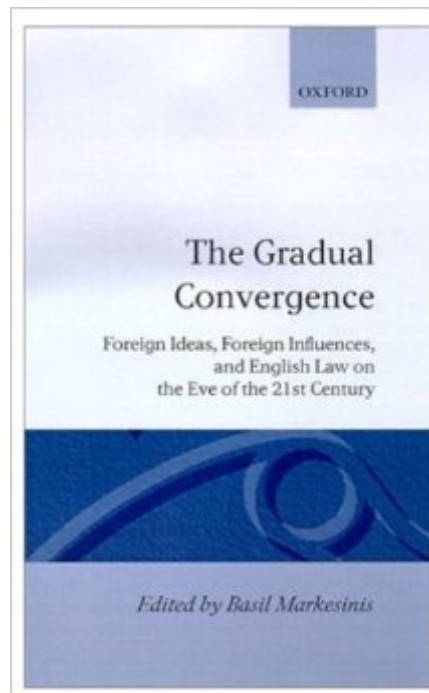


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# The Gradual Convergence: Foreign Ideas, Foreign Influences, And English Law On The Eve Of The 21st Century
